Finding matching bibliographic records

The 2 most important factors in determining matching bibliographic records are FORMAT and CONTENT. Different formats require separate bib records. Conducting a **GENERAL KEYWORD** search is the recommended search method in both the SEO catalog and CatExpress. **BROWSE** type searching is not recommended because items in certain non-circulating statuses negatively affect the results.

Different formats for BOOKS in the SEO catalog are:

- Regular print (<u>Larger</u> print books get attached to the regular print bib record)
- Large print [large print]
- Songbooks and/or sheet music [musical score]
- Atlases [map]
- Board books [board book]
- Big books (oversized juvenile books) [big book]
- Braille books [braille]

√Content that MUST MATCH includes:

- ✓ Author(s)
- ✓ Title
- ✓Subtitle (except "a novel")
- ✓ Illustrator(s)
- √Adapted by statements
- ✓ Edition statements that refer to content (e.g. 2nd ed, revised ed.)

Content that is NOT required to match includes:

- ⊗ISBN or other standard number(s)
- ⊗Edition statements that do not refer to content (e.g. Book Club ed., paperback ed.)
- ⊗Publisher and/or printer
- ⊗Publication date
- Number of pages
